### **Group exhibitions and other art work**

Isabel Sabino presented art works in several dozens of group exhibitions, under jury selection, since 1977. The most outstanding were perhaps the various editions of O Papel como Suporte and other collective shows in SNBA in the seventies and eighties, and also Bienal de Lagos, Bienal de Vila Nova de Cerveira, NovosNovos, Exposição Comemorativa dos 150 Anos do Montepio Geral (1990), D. Sebastião in Secretaria de Estado da Cultura (1992). Her work has been seen too in gallery representations in Lisbon Art Fair, ArteLisboa 2002, 2003 and 2004, and in Bienal do Montijo 2005. Furthermore, she produced paintings addressed to private and public spaces, worked in graphic design and illustration, accomplished site intervention projects, and directed the space concept and design of the exhibitions she curated for Centro Cultural Malaposta/Amascultura.
